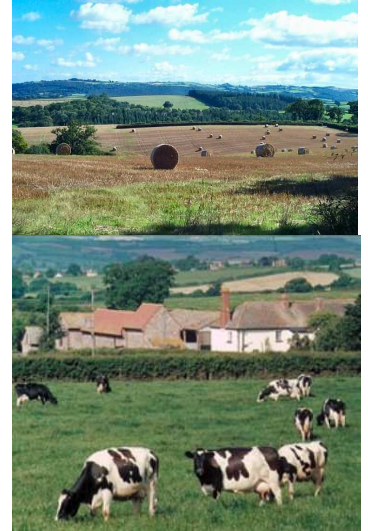
Exeter 2012 :
